2. Measures taken to complete the syllabus of courses and programs.	<p>The teacher entered to the class regularly and sincerely. He used different techniques like tools, methods, and terminologies for impacting and interesting of the class. The class was conducted according to the lesson plan. The lesson plan was made at least forty number of classes to complete the syllabus. The teacher was following the central time table to conduct the classes. The teacher was acquired knowledge about the objective of the class, how did he string a syllabus together in a way that clearly demonstrates the arc or theory of the course. The best process here was to start with the ideas or key learning's and then mapped out the course from beginning to end, module by module. Critical in this process—and this was true for any syllabus—was how he created links between one class and the next, between one module and the next, and between each case or course assignment. Then, at the end, it was known that everything tied together and assigned for a purpose. The assignment was given in a sequence order according to prescribed module. When the teacher moved through the syllabus, two things are happening i.e. developing the technical content while keeping pace with the overall takeaways for each case, each module, and the course as a whole.</p> <p>The most interesting managerial questions required to use judgment, which involved applying the technical knowledge, decision-making ability and leadership skills. When instructors created enough tension within these cases, students remembered the technique long after leaving the classroom because it was helpful in solving and managing a problem. This was where a clear syllabus was a useful tool to show students how they were learned the technique and then actually use the information they gained and understood why it was important. It was also important to pick cases or other course materials that represented different contextual variables: The teacher was ready to send the PDF of the course coverage of the class. The class conductance was followed by central time table. The course coverage for the 1st internal was completed in due period and materials related to the internal Examination was sent to the students. Similarly the exact course coverage was completed before the 2nd internal and PDF materials were sent to the students. After completion of the internal examinations as well as course coverage, a numbers of revised classes were conducted to increase the confident of the students. As a result, the students were encouraged to appear the University Examination and finally they were success in the examination.</p>
